

As the most significant international biological threat in the past 100 years, this brief introductory section presents the June milestones of the COVID-19 pandemic.




# OVERVIEW OF COVID-19 PANDEMIC



- Over 2.6 million new cases were reported last week, a 7% increase compared to the previous period, following six consecutive weeks of declining numbers.
- The global case increase was driven by increases in the Eastern Mediterranean (14%), South-East Asia (9%), Europe (9%) and the Americas (6%).
- Possible reasons for this increase include the continued spread of more transmissible variants of concern (VOCs), relaxation of public health and social measures (PHSM) and fatigue around adhering to PSHM measures.
- The number of global new deaths continues to decrease, with over 63 000 new deaths reported last week, a 6% decrease as compared to the previous week. New deaths decreased in four regions, Europe, Africa the Western Pacific, and the Americas (by 15%, 19%, 35% and 1%, respectively), and increased by 47% in the South East Asia Region, partly due to retrospective reporting of deaths from Nepal.



#### **Tunisia**

#### **Ammonium Nitrate Shortage**

**Event** – SYNAGRI holds gov't responsible for agricultural ammonium nitrates shortage. **Summary** – The Tunisian Farmers' Union (SYNAGRI) called for providing the necessary quantity of agricultural ammonium nitrates to save the different agricultural seasons and to import additional quantity from neighbouring countries in a bid to overcome the lack reported at the national level.

#### **Dengue Fever**

**Event** – Dengue outbreak.

**Summary** – The World Health Organization Ethiopia country office is working with Somali Regional Health Bureau to contain the spread of dengue fever in the region. Close to 160 confirmed cases have been recorded in Warder Woreda of Dolo Zone and 47 suspected cases in Dolo Ado Woreda of Liban Zone. Samples of the suspected cases from Dolo Ado have been sent to the regional laboratory in Hawassa for confirmation.

## **Democratic Republic of Congo**

#### Measles

**Event** – Outbreak update.

**Summary** – The UN Office for the Coordination of Humanitarian Affairs (OCHA) reports measles has resurfaced in the Democratic Republic of Congo (DRC) provinces of North and South Ubangui with cases rising to 4,500 since the outbreak mid–December 2020, affecting mostly children under five years. Many of the cases are complicated and associated with malnutrition.

#### **Polio Virus**

**Event** – Outbreak update.

**Summary** – The Minister of Health has issued a statement declaring Polio outbreak within the country as a "National Public Health Emergency". The statement from Minister followed the detection of poliovirus by the National Surveillance System, which has spread throughout the country from two different environmental sites in Monrovia. Under the National Polio Emergency, the Health Minister says immediate measures that include door–to–door Polio vaccination campaign will take place in every community across the Country to monitor the situation within the country to beef up the fight against Polio.

#### **South Africa**

**Event** – Containment refuted reinforcement.

**Summary** – South African utility Eskom and the National Nuclear Regulator have refuted media reports that the reinforced concrete containment buildings at the Koeberg nuclear power plant have suffered extensive corrosion and would not be able to prevent the release of radiation in the event of a severe accident. They say tests have confirmed the performance of the structures, to which repairs have already been made. The National Nuclear Regulator (NNR) confirmed that the Koeberg Alert Alliance (KAA) plant currently complies with regular tests required by the regulator. With the information at the disposal NNR can confirm that despite the concrete cracking and delamination observed on the outer surface, the containment structures remain currently effective for protecting the environment from radiation during accident conditions.

#### **Paraxylene Production**

**Event** – China's self-sufficiency in Paraxylene to impact chemical shipping market in 2021. **Summary** – Paraxylene is the second-largest organic chemical carried by chemical tankers. In 2020, Paraxylene comprised 17.1% in the total organics seaborne trade. However, trade volumes have been declining since 2018 due to the expansion of Chinese domestic capacity. China is the world's largest importer of Paraxylene but in 2021 imports are expected to fall by 10% as the country's domestic production capacity will grow by 9.8 million tonnes.

When livestock farmers produce more fertilizers than they are allowed to use on their own land, they must transport the surplus to manure processors or to arable farmers who still have room to spread manure. Livestock farmers have to incur costs for this. The suspected intermediaries, transporters and processors presumably manipulate administration and mandatory fertilizer samples.

The study involved scientists from Japan, Finland, France, the UK, and USA, and was led by Dr. Satoshi Utsunomiya and graduate student Kazuya Morooka (Department of Chemistry, Kyushu University). The team used a combination of advanced analytical techniques (synchrotron-based nano-focus X-ray analysis, secondary ion mass spectrometry, and high-resolution transmission electron microscopy) to fully characterize the particles.

# **Artificial Intelligence**

**Event** – 31st MEU tests artificial intelligence sensing gear to help Marines, soldiers see invisible threats.
